3. RE-SCHEDULE: A player who is not able to play on schedule has to notify the tournament director before the round starts and his game will be re-scheduled.
4. REPORTING: Do not write results in the score table. Indicate results in the pairings list.
5. GENERAL RULES: In accordance with FIDE and USCF rules.
