

United States.—We have two notes of Maroczy's exhibition tour through the States, one from Rochester, N. Y., where on February 27th he met 20 opponents, winning 18 games and losing 2; the other from Los Angeles, where on April 18th he played 28 games, of which he won 15, drew 11, and lost 2. Just before his visit to Los Angeles he had made a score of 30 wins, 7 draws and one loss at San Francisco.

In the championship of the Los Angeles Chess and Checker Club S. Mlotkowski and S. Weinbaum have tied, with scores of  $12\frac{1}{2}$  out of 18.

At Laguna Beach on April 26th Los Angeles defeated San Diego by 16—2.
