No losses were plenty

Gee Keeps Sacramento Crown

Defending city champion J. B. Gee found that no losses were plenty in this year's Sacramento tournament. Scoring five straight wins, he nonetheless took the

title by a mere half point over M. O. Meyer. Due to the vagaries of the Swiss system, the two players did not meet each other; thus Meyer amassed $4\frac{1}{2}-1\frac{1}{2}$ to finish close behind Gee. D. J. Yuke, C. J. Carey and A. R. Chapman, all with $3\frac{1}{2}-1\frac{1}{2}$, were third, fourth and fifth, respectively. Seventeen players participated in the tournament.
