VENTURA SUPERB HOSTS FOR CALIFORNIA OPEN

The California State Chess Federation indeed raises its hat, or many hats, in true appreciation, to the fine Ventura Chess Club for its excellent sponsoring and organization of the facilities and arrangements for the 1970 CALIFORNIA OPEN, which turned out to be one of the most successful ever held, if not THE most successful. With 166 enthusiastic participants, including plenty of top strength, this is bound to be one of the largest turnouts ever - though we don't have the records available. The Calif. Chess Reporter will no doubt give some statistics.

The tournament was held at the Civic Rec. Center in Ventura, one of the finest facilities for such an event anywhere in the state. A large playing room, with plenty of light, a big balcony overlooking the Pacific, analysis and rapid transit room downstairs, a fine snack bar on the premises, no overcrowded tables, helpful club members and their families to keep things going - who could ask for anything more? Our thanks indeed to Messrs. LUNDE, SANDERS, BUONOCORE and others of Ventura for all their efforts. We're looking forward to a tremendous U.S. OPEN next year at this city - make your plans now!

Now to the winners. Our congratulations to Tibor WEINBERGER, well-known Santa Monica master and winner of untold events in past years, for taking clear first and the Open title with a score of 6½-½. Tibor drew one game against runner-up Walter CUNNINGHAM, and electrified the watching crowd in the last round in an exciting game against David FORTHOFFER which went down to the wire, to mate. FORTHOFFER turned in a great performance, drawing with Julio KAPLAN and defeating Irving RIVISE along the way, but couldn't hold WEINBERGER. On this game depended the title and \$500 first prize.

In a three-way tie for second, salutations are due CUNNINGHAM, who also drew with Norman MILLER (one time of Fresno, now of Los Angeles), Alex SUHOBECK and Jeff KENT, a Class A player who defeated DAHLBERGS and REMLINGER in the last two rounds to attain his heights. The Expert prizes were split six ways, by Art SPILLER, Jose TOSSAS, Ray MARTIN, Julius LOFTSSON, John DAVIDIAN and Dave FORTHOFFER. Class A 2nd, Larry NEZHNI and Sid RUBIN: Class B, Roger ALEXANDER and R. JOSEPH: Class C, J.L. PETERSON and Norm KRAVITZ: D-u/r, Jeff CRANE and R. UITTO.
