The unique event, sponsored by the Piatigorsky Foundation, is planned as the first of a series of biennial tournaments that may ultimately occupy a similar position in the world of chess that the Davis Cup does in tennis. The prizes are the largest ever offered in any chess tournament. There will be fourteen rounds of play, at the Ambassador Hotel on Wilshire Boulevard. Tournament Director: International grandmaster Isaac KASHDAN. Organizer of the tournament: Mrs. J. PIATIGORSKY, one of the top ten women chess players in the U.S.

TEAM MATCHES IN FULL SWING

Round Two fully completed -- with the exception of a couple of adjournments and time-rearranged games. L.A. STATE turns in perfect score of 6-0 against South Bay, who lost three points on forfeits -- a pity! The STEINER MASTERS are plunging through smooth waters to lead Division A with 10½ points, with one game adjourned; defending champions SANTA MONICA follows closely with 9½ - 2½. The champs were obliged to give up 1½ points to a much-improved MONTEREY PARK team.

CITY TERRACE took measure of COVINA with a fine showing of 4½-1½. Division B also produced a runaway match, when SANTA MONICA B finished off PASADENA B in a 6-0 display. ALONDRA and the INDEPENDENTS had a bit of trouble getting together, so we have only an incomplete result here. The field in this division is pretty well bunched up, though nothing is too indicative after only two rounds, and two teams having had byes.

In Division C, three teams are up on top with scores of 9-3 and 8½-3½: SANTA MONICA C, MONTEREY PARK CHALLENGERS and STEINER Cavaliers. Top-rated LONG BEACH STATE COLLEGE in Division D is indeed running away with honors so far, with 10 - 2 to their credit. PLUMMER PARK has proved to be the dark horse in this division; they took CITY TERRACE valiants 4-2 in Round one, and now collected 2½ more points against WESTCHESTER B to give them 6½ points and a tie with COVINA B, WESTCHESTER B and WHITTIER B at the 2-4 spot.

The great number of close match scores and ties certainly indicates the fine distribution of strength (in general) due to the divisional system.

But enough chitchat for now -- on with the scores!
