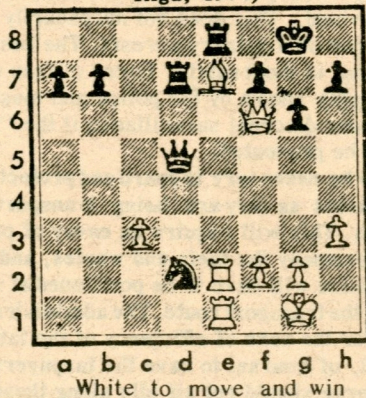


Big-Time Chess In 1975
