

# KPFA's Second Chess-Game-on-the-Air

For the second time in recent weeks, a unique chess program has been presented over station KPFA-FM in Berkeley—a full-length game by strong amateurs with comments, inaudible to the

players, by Jens L. Lund and George Koltanowski.

(a) 4.PxP.NxP: 5.P-K4 is considered better. (b) I prefer 7.B-Q2 followed by 8.R-B1. (c) A well-calculated move! It takes over the initiative. (d) Black must have had this in mind when he played 9... P-QB4. (e) Waste of time. QR-B1 is better. (f) Wins a pawn and the game.
