

United States.—The annual club tournament at Los Angeles attracted 19 entries last time, and in the double-round preliminary section the following qualified for the final by scoring over 60 per cent. (not all the games being played out):—S. Mlotkowski, $31\frac{1}{2}$ points in 33 games; H. Borochow, 26 in 30; E. R. Perry, 22 in 32; J. W. Gill, 21 in 34; S. O. Long, 22 in 36. C. J. Bergman also qualified but did not compete in the final, which was another double-round affair between the other 5. The final placings were:—I Perry, 8; II Borochow, $5\frac{1}{2}$; III Mlotkowski, 4; IV Gill, 2; and V Long, $\frac{1}{2}$.

Mr. Mlotkowski had been finding the pressure of writing work very heavy and has relinquished the chess editorship of *The Los Angeles Examiner*, in which Mr. Borochow has succeeded him.
