## BERKELEY FALL QUARTER SWISS RESULTS

The Second Annual Fall Quarter Swiss was held in the Student Union Building on the University of California Berkeley campus, Nov. 4-5. USCF Senior Tournament Director Alan Benson organized and directed the four-round, USCF-Cal Chess Swiss system event, sponsored by SUPERB, which attracted 83 players. Nearly \$1,000 worth of prizes (\$844.25 in cash, \$80 in Gambit Game Store gift certificates plus five plaque trophies) was awarded to 30 winners in five divisions.
