"A PIECE OF THE ACTION" RESULTS

Evidently enticed by a cash prize fund of \$1,364 plus five trophies and \$100 in Gambit Game Store gift certificates, 116 chess players showed up for Alan Benson's "A Piece of the Action" tournament on the University of California Berkeley campus, Jan. 6-7.
