"PEOPLE'S CHESS TOURNAMENT" RESULTS

The eighth annual "People's Chess Tournament", a USCF-rated, six-round Swiss system competition in six playing divisions, was held in the Pauley Ballroom of the U.C. Berkeley Student Union, Feb. 14-16.

Sponsored jointly by SUPERB and the U.C. Berkeley Campus Chess Club, the \$2,810.97 event (\$2,670.97 in cash prizes, \$140 in California Chess Bulletins gift certificates and 13 trophies) attracted 209 players, directed by USCF Senior Regional Vice President Alan Benson, assisted by Sr. T.D. Mike Goodall and Local T.D. Mike Donald.
